

Greenfield Hall, Multi Use Centre, Sherborne International College

The works comprised the construction of a single storey multi-purpose hall located within the school grounds.

At one end of the hall is a raised stage and at the other is a mezzanine (balcony).

Externally there is a retaining wall to the back of the building and a link corridor that enables access from the adjacent building.

There are traditional foundations, a steel frame and brick and block cavity walls. The roof is formed with rafters attached to steel purlins. The roof is weathered with plain tiles.

The building has been awarded a BREEAM 'Very Good' rating.
