The contract to construct this stunning building was won in a two-stage tender competition where our team were able to draw on their experience on previous projects to convince the client and his team of our ability to complete this technically demanding structure.

The job involved a complex demolition operation followed by careful planning of the piling, foundation and steelwork contracts to achieve the curved shape of the building.

Internally top quality finishes were required and the timber panelling in the church itself is particularly effective (see photograph, right).

The project was particularly challenging because of the footprint of the building virtually matching the shape of the site. Space was available for a tower crane, but site accommodation and a small amount of material storage was placed in a small area loaned by the council.
