



## Yew Wah International Education Foundation Knowle Hall, Bridgwater

Knowle Hall, a small country house in Tudor-Gothic style, was built in between 1829-1833. It is now a residential education facility occupied by Yew Wah International Education Foundation who promote holistic education, to create a positive and caring educational environment.

This project, which commenced in September 2015, comprises the conversion, renovation and extension of the building for a Cultural Learning Centre to include classrooms, dormitories and staff accommodation. The works also included the demolition of other buildings within the grounds which will provide the formation of play areas, tennis courts and an amphitheatre.
