

## Netham Park Pavilion, Bristol

This technically challenging project was located in the middle of a large playing field facility situated just off the M32 in Bristol. The site features a sharp drop of some 4m between the lower and upper fields and the pavilion was located at this point allowing access to the club room at higher level and direct egress from the changing rooms at lower level.

The ground floor is housed within a large concrete retaining structure and the upper floor features a concrete/timber/steel frame with glazed elevations and composite panel cladding. The changing rooms are well finished with quality fittings, tiled floors and solid laminate wall cladding in the showers.

A feature of the service provision is the choice of a wood pellet boiler which assisted with the energy rating of the building and allows the Parks Department to recycle its waste timber.

The building is served by access roads extensive car parking.

Once again this project was the product of a partnering agreement with our client and our input in the second stage tender process was crucial.
