

**Triscombe House
Quantock Hills
Somerset**

The Company has enjoyed a long association with Triscombe House.

Commissioned at the start of the 20th Century the company built the property for a wealthy mill owner who took occupation in 1904. Over the next 100 years the house passed through several owners and in 2002 a serious fire destroyed the roof and a large part of the first floor. Flooding by fire-fighters and inclement weather further added to the problems and the resulting ruin was declared a dangerous structure.

The current owners purchased the derelict building and set about restoring it to its former glory. Initially they approached Pollards to have the remaining structure stabilised. In a carefully controlled operation we gradually made-safe areas, removing all loose structural material and erecting scaffold support and temporary roofing.

Following on from the success of the initial works the company was retained to complete the restoration of the building. This included intricate detailing, luxury fittings and a wide range of external features such as walled gardens, utility areas and a new access drive.
